- Should circumstances so dictate, the Scottish Gundog Association, in consultation with the judge, might alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club at the earliest opportunity.
- No modification will be made to this schedule except by the permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before closing of entries.
